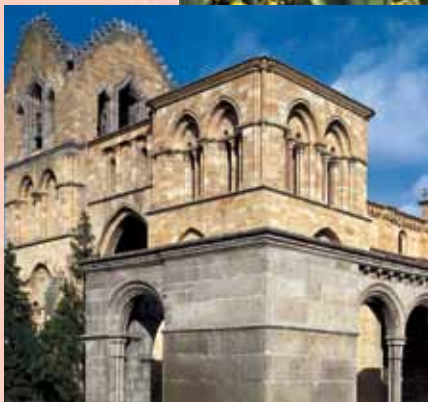

## OUR DAILY ITINERARY

**WED, DEC 28, DAY 1: DEPART USA:** We depart Sacramento by motor coach for San Francisco airport where we board our international flight to Madrid with complimentary meals and beverages served aloft.

**THU, DEC 29, DAY 2: ARRIVE MADRID:** We arrive this evening in Madrid and are met by our Catholic Travel Centre representative, who will accompany us throughout the tour. We transfer to our hotel followed by dinner. (D)

**FRI, DEC 30, DAY 3: MADRID: CITY TOUR, PRADO & BUEN RETIRO PARK:** Today we begin our tour at the heart of the city, at the Plaza Mayor, the Main Square of the city, and one of the most striking central squares of any city in Europe, and probably the world. Over the centuries this square has been a venue for tournaments, weddings, and bullfights! The ground floor of most buildings is full of cafes, restaurants, and shops which are all appealing to the tourists. You may see street vendors or local artists as well.

Our city tour continues to the modern Cathedral, which is actually quite modern as Spanish churches go. We visit as well another famous plaza, the Plaza del Sol, a bustling hub that marks the former location of the eastern wall of the city in the 15th century.

Our tour concludes at the Prado Museum, one of the world's premier treasure troves of art, featuring masterpieces by Picasso, Goya, Vazquez, Gaudi, Rubens and Miro. It is rivaled only by the Louvre in Paris and the Hermitage in St. Petersburg. After our tour here, we gather for lunch at a local restaurant. The balance of the afternoon is at

leisure. You may wish to take a stroll in Buen Retiro Park, the city's grand, centrally located park. For those of us wishing to dine together this evening, our tour guide will assist us with restaurant selections. (B, L)

**SAT, DEC 31, DAY 4: MADRID: AVILA EXCURSION:** Today we make a full day's excursion to the walled town of Avila, made famous by St. Teresa, another Doctor of the Church. Because of its charm and beauty, Avila has been classified as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. In Avila, we visit the Monastery of the Incarnation where St. Teresa spent many years of her life, then to the Monastery of St. Joseph, her first foundation. We will gather at a local restaurant inside the walls of the Old City of Avila. After our lunch we return to Madrid for some leisure time in preparation for the New Year's Eve Celebration. (B, L)

**SUN, JAN 1, DAY 5: MADRID: TOLEDO EXCURSION:** This morning we embark to the city of Toledo, a magical town south of Madrid. In 1985 Toledo was proclaimed a UNESCO World Heritage Site for its extensive cultural and monumental heritage as one of the former capitals of the Spanish Empire. The Cathedral of Toledo is one of Europe's greatest Gothic achievements, known for its stunning high altar. There are more than 20 chapels throughout the cathedral, many of which house renowned tombs. The cathedral is also home to two famous paintings by El Greco, the master painter who lived in Toledo. Our choir will sing the Sunday liturgy at the Cathedral or at one of the local churches (pending availability and confirmation).

After Mass and a walking tour, we gather for a special New Year's Day lunch at a local restaurant. We return to Madrid for the balance of the day at leisure. (B, L)

**MON, JAN 2, DAY 6: MADRID / CACERES:** Today we leave Madrid for Guadalupe, traveling through some breathtakingly beautiful mountain scenery. We arrive at the Monastery of Guadalupe, housing some of Spain's finest artistic treasures. Pilgrims have flocked here since the 14th century, when a shepherd uncovered a miraculous statue of the Virgin, said to have been carved by St. Luke. It was in the name of the Virgin of Guadalupe that the conquistadors set off to explore the New World.

After our visit to Guadalupe, we make our way west to Caceres, our final destination today. Caceres ranks as a UNESCO World Heritage Site and has been nominated as the Cultural Capital of Europe for 2016. A walk through the Old City here takes you back to the 15th and 16th centuries. Dinner is served at our hotel in Caceres. (B, D)

**TUE, JAN 3, DAY 7: CACERES TOUR / CONTINUE TO FATIMA:** We will have some time for a brief walking tour of Caceres this morning, taking us back in time of the Roman and Moorish periods. Many of the noble families from Caceres funded and participated in the discovery and exploration of the Americas. Our walking tour takes us to some of the beautiful public squares and exquisite churches.

Our motor coach will then take us across western Spain and cross the border into Portugal; we make our way to the town of Fatima, taking some time to orient ourselves before settling down for the evening for dinner at our hotel. (B,D)

**WED, JAN 4, DAY 8: FATIMA: VISIT OF SHRINE & AFTERNOON EXCURSION TO NAZARE:** This morning we begin with Mass at the Little Chapel of the Apparitions. We visit the Tombs of the visionaries Francisco, Jacinto, and Lucia; the Aljustrel where the children lived; and the Valinhos, where Our Lady appeared after the children's return from prison. We have the option of praying the Stations of the Cross, plus we have time for our own devotions.

For those who are interested, we have included an afternoon excursion to the charming seaside village of Nazare, named after 'Nazareth,' the hometown of the Holy Family in the Holy Land. You'll have time to visit the Chapel of Our Lady of Nazare, a local devotion to the Black Madonna. Plus you can stroll the quaint seaside promenade and do some shopping. Return to Fatima for dinner and the evening at our hotel. (B, D)

**THU, JAN 5, DAY 9: FATIMA / SANTAREM / LISBON:** We depart for Santarem, noted for its devotion to the Blessed Sacrament. Here we celebrate Mass at the Church of the Holy Miracle, formerly St. Stephen's Church. This is one of Portugal's most beloved pilgrimage sites. St. Francis Xavier, SJ, stopped here to pray before heading off for his missionary work in the Far East. Back on our motor coach, we continue on to Lisbon to check-in to our hotel for dinner and the evening. (B, D)

**FRI, JAN 6, DAY 10: LISBON: VISIT OF THE CITY:** We begin with a visit to 'Santo Antonio Da Se,' marking the site where in 1195 St. Anthony of Padua, the patron saint of Portugal, was born. Many of us know St. Anthony as the Patron Saint of Lost Articles! We continue to the Cathedral, housing the Saint's baptismal font. Here we celebrate Mass and the Cathedral Choir will sing the Sunday liturgy (pending confirmation).

Following Mass, we gather for a celebratory farewell lunch at a local restaurant. The afternoon is at our leisure

and we have time to pack and prepare for our journey home tomorrow. Our tour guide will have some suggestions on where we can dine this evening, for those wishing to be together for dinner. (B, L)

**SAT, JAN 7, DAY 11: RETURN USA:** We transfer to Lisbon airport for our return flight to the United States. Upon arrival and clearing customs we will board our motor coach bound from Sacramento. (B)

*Note: While no changes are anticipated, there may be unforeseen occasions when certain alterations become necessary to this itinerary, either due to changes in airline schedules or for other reasons. All Masses are subject to local church schedules and substitution with alternate Mass sites if churches mentioned are not available.*

## Terms and Conditions

Making any payments (cash, credit card or otherwise) towards any tour constitutes your unconditional acceptance of all the terms and conditions stated in this tour brochure. Catholic Travel Centre shall be referred to as CTC within this document.

**DOCUMENTS:** US citizens require a valid passport. Other nationalities please inquire with the appropriate embassies. Passports must be valid for six months beyond the tour's return date.

**REGISTRATION AND DEPOSITS:** A deposit of \$400 per person is required upon registration along with a signed copy of the registration form. Registrations cannot be taken by telephone. Registrations are processed in the order received by CTC. Balance of payment is due 90 days prior to departure. Late payment is subject to \$50 late fee. Late registrations (fewer than 90 days) must be accompanied by full payment by cashiers check only (including the optional passenger travel protection program payment, if applicable), plus a \$50 late fee and are subject to availability. CTC reserves the right to cancel reservations that are not paid in full 75 days prior to departure and to charge cancellation fees/penalties indicated below. A \$25 fee will be charged on all checks returned by our bank.

**CHANGES IN INVOICING:** Please note that after initial invoicing, any requests for change in form of payment (cash discount vs. standard base) or in package (air inclusive vs. "land only") are subject to a \$50 per person per change processing fee.
